



THADDEUS (AKA: Judas son of James / Some manuscripts give his first name as Lebbeus): Had to be distinguished from Judas Iscariot	Missionary in India, Siam, Malabar, Syria, Libya, Mesopotamia and Armenia	Crucified; Old age; behead with clubs at crucifixion	Mt 3:13-19; Mk 10:1-4; Lk 6:13-16; Jn 14:22
SIMON (AKA: the Zealot, 'The Cananaean'):	Missionary in Egypt, Persia, Armenia and Syria	Crucified; Old age	Mt 3:13-19; Mk 10:1-4; Lk 6:13-16
JUDAS ISCARIOT: Betrayed Jesus	Self; Betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver	Crucified; Suicide by hanging	Mt 2:13-19; Mk 10:1-4; 27:3-10; Lk 6:13-16; Acts 1:18
MATTHIAS: Replaced Judas	Missionary in India and Colchis	Crucified; beheaded, or crucified	Acts 1:15-26

The name 'personas' is given different names when the Gospel texts (e.g. Mary Magdalene and Mary of Bethany). Followers attributed here are among the most well-known (as mentioned in the Gospels). Later church tradition and legends about their lives after the resurrection of Jesus are a matter of faith and not confirmed. A list of all names of Jesus is given here.
